

Regulations

1. The judges decisions shall be final, unless a protest in writing against a decision by them be lodged with the Show Secretary by 2pm on the day of judging, together with a deposit of £1 which shall be forfeited should the Committee consider the objection to be unwarranted.
2. **STAGING TIMES** Exhibits may be staged from 3pm until 10pm on Tuesday 24th June 2008. The marquee must be vacated by 10.15pm on Tuesday. Access for checking exhibits will be allowed from 6.00am - 6.30am on Wednesday 25th June.
3. Exhibits **MUST NOT** be removed before 5pm on Thursday 26th June when a bell will be rung at the close.
4. Nothing may be attached to the staging background. Classes 2, 3,4,5, 6, 7 & 8 are staged on tables approx. 80cm deep against a background 120cm high. Background and tabling **black**. Class 1 will be staged on grass on a circular base (supplied) 120cms diameter, 2 cm thick and approx 8cm from the ground. Exhibitor should provide own covering and skirt for base.
5. An exhibitor may place only one entry in each class.
6. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis depending on the availability of space. All entries will be acknowledged but **ONLY** if accompanied by a **SAE**. PLEASE NOTE CLUB CLASS LIMITED TO 9 EXHIBITS
7. All exhibits and exhibitors' property will be at the risk of the exhibitor. The NNHS and the RNAA cannot be held responsible in any way for any loss or damage sustained by the exhibitor.
8. Exhibitors cards **MUST** be collected from the Show Secretary and displayed face down on the exhibit prior to judging.
9. All exhibits must be the unaided work of the competitor and must be assembled in the marquee with the exception of Class 7 which may be submitted already assembled.
10. **ALL MEASUREMENTS GIVEN ARE APPROXIMATE**. All exhibits to be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual First Edition 2001.
11. Aerosol sprays **MUST NOT** be used in the marquee.
12. **NOVICE CLASS** is open only to competitors who have never won a First Prize in Flower Arranging Classes at any NNHS Show.
Dried/Preserved plant material may be included unless otherwise stated.
NO PAINTED FRESH PLANT MATERIAL is permitted.
- 13 **All rubbish to be removed by the exhibitor(s).**

TICKETS Each exhibitor in the open classes (with the exception of 7 & 8) will receive one ticket for entry into the Showground together with a car park ticket. . Concessionary entrance tickets can be obtained from the Show Secretary of NNHS at a cost of £16 (£14 Senior Citizen). There is no limit but tickets must be ordered and paid for when sending entries. **PLEASE NOTE** tickets will **ONLY** be sent where remittance and SAE are included with entries. Cheques to be made payable to NNHS.

CLASS F2 EXPLORATION

An exhibit. Space allowed 75cms Name of explorer to be displayed.

CLASS F3 BEYOND THE DEEP

A Seascape. Space allowed 75cms.

CLASS F4 INTO THE UNKNOWN

A MODERN exhibit. Space allowed 75cms.

CLASS F5 NATURES TREASURES (NOVICE CLASS)

An exhibit. Space allowed 60cms.
The NOLLER CUP will be awarded for the best exhibit in this class.

CLASS F6 DISCOVERED IN THE ATTIC

An exhibit of dried and/or preserved plant material. Space allowed 75cms.
The SEAFIELD GRANT TROPHY will be awarded for the best exhibit in this class.
