Flower classes

- 1 single Rose flower floating in a bowl
- 2 3 Roses in a vase
- 3 any 3 Sweet Pea stems
- 4 any 3 stems of Pinks
- 5 vase of mixed Annuals
- 6 vase of mixed Perennials
- 7 vase of mixed Shrubs
- 8 one specimen flower spike in a vase
- 9 vase of mixed Herbs
- 10 A dried flower arrangement, space allowed 50cm wide and deep, brought ready assembled

Fruit classes

- 11 3 Plums
- 12 6 Raspberries
- 13 5 sprigs of Currants
- 14 any other fruit, up to 3 of same variety

Pot plant classes. All pots maximum size 20cms diameter (except class 18)

- 15 Cactus or succulent
- 16 Pot plant flowering
- 17 Pot plant foliage
- 18 Competition Dahlia, shown as grown, in a pot (any size)

Vegetable classes

- 19 3 Potatoes same variety
- 20 3 Carrots, with tops trimmed to approximately 7cm
- 21 3 Beetroot, with tops
- 22 1 Lettuce, roots in polythene bag
- 23 2 Courgettes
- 24 any other vegetable, up to 3 of same variety

Photography, maximum size 20 by 15 cm

- 25 Prickly
- 26 Water

Domestic classes

- 27 3 rock buns
- 28 3 cheese straws
- 29 jar of jam or jelly
- 30 jar of pickle
- 31 jar of chutney
- 32 A handmade textile (e.g. knitted, crocheted, sewn or embroidered)
- 33 Any other handmade craft item with a gardening theme

Children's classes (under 12)

- 34 An animal made out of fruit and/or vegetables
- 35 A garden on a plate
